

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF
JEFFREY THOMAS SPANGLER

I, Jeffrey Thomas Spangler, a Pennsylvania citizen residing at 6151 Acorn Drive, Spring Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and over the age of eighteen (18) years, and not being actuated by any duress, menace, fraud, mistake, or undue influence, do make, publish, and declare this to be my last Will, expressly revoking all Wills and Codicils previously made by me.

EXECUTOR: I appoint the Register of Wills of the York County, or any person designated by a Judge of the York County Court of Common Pleas, as Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, at the expense of the County, but I expressly do not authorize any of my relatives or friends to serve. My Executor shall be authorized but not required to carry out all provisions of this Will, arrange for my organ donations, pay minimal expenses for prompt cremation and disposal, decline to pay my debts and disclaim my obligations because my Estate is insolvent.

BEQUESTS: I give my Lehigh University ring to Stephanie A. Ennis.

ALL REMAINING PROPERTY; RESIDUARY CLAUSE: I give, devise, and bequeath all of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, of whatever kind and character, and wherever located, to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for distribution to non-religious charities if that property is of any value.

WAIVER OF BOND, INVENTORY, ACCOUNTING, REPORTING AND APPROVAL: My Executor and alternate Executor shall serve without any bond, and I hereby waive the necessity of preparing or filing any inventory, accounting, appraisal, reporting, approvals or final appraisement of my estate. I direct that no expert appraisal be made of my estate unless required by law.

OPTIONAL PROVISIONS: I adopt as part of this Will my desire that my remains after any appropriate organ donations be promptly cremated, and that my ashes be disposed of by spreading them upon the Conewago Creek or its banks in Adams County, Pennsylvania if permitted by law, and if not, to be buried in the potter's field of any public cemetery.

SEVERABILITY AND SURVIVAL: If any part of this Will is declared invalid, illegal, or inoperative for any reason, it is my intent that the remaining parts shall be effective and fully operative, and that any Court so interpreting this Will and any provision in it construe in favor of survival.
