

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF
JEFFREY THOMAS SPANGLER

I, Jeffrey Thomas Spangler, a Virginia citizen residing at 1011 Arlington Boulevard #925, Arlington, Virginia, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and over the age of eighteen (18) years, and not being actuated by any duress, menace, fraud, mistake, or undue influence, do make, publish, and declare this to be my last Will, expressly revoking all Wills and Codicils previously made by me.

EXECUTOR: I appoint the Clerk of Court of Arlington County Circuit Court, or any person designated by a judge of that Court, as Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, at the expense of the County, but I do not authorize any of my relatives or friends to serve. My Executor shall be authorized to carry out all provisions of this Will, arrange for any organ donations, pay minimal funeral expenses for prompt cremation and disposal, decline to pay my debts and disclaim my obligations because my Estate is insolvent.

BEQUESTS: I will, give, and bequeath unto the following persons, if they survive me, the following property: (1) to my brother Ted William Spangler I give my Civil War saber; (2) to my brother Jack Donald Spangler I give my ceremonial Oriental sword, both of which were bequests to me from our father. If either of my brothers predeceases me, the bequest to him shall lapse, and the property shall pass to his eldest living child. If I do not possess or own any property listed above on the date of my death, the bequest of that property shall lapse.

ALL REMAINING PROPERTY; RESIDUARY CLAUSE: I give, devise, and bequeath all of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, of whatever kind and character, and wherever located, to the Commonwealth of Virginia for distribution to non-religious charities if that property is of any value.

WAIVER OF BOND, INVENTORY, ACCOUNTING, REPORTING AND APPROVAL: My Executor and alternate Executor shall serve without any bond, and I hereby waive the necessity of preparing or filing any inventory, accounting, appraisal, reporting, approvals or final appraisement of my estate. I direct that no expert appraisal be made of my estate unless required by law.

OPTIONAL PROVISIONS: I adopt as part of this Will my desire that my remains after any appropriate organ donations be promptly cremated, and that my ashes be disposed of by spreading them upon the Potomac River or its banks in Arlington County if permitted by law, and if not, to be buried in the potter's field of any public cemetery in Arlington County.

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SEVERABILITY AND SURVIVAL: If any part of this Will is declared invalid, illegal, or inoperative for any reason, it is my intent that the remaining parts shall be effective and fully operative, and that any Court so interpreting this Will and any provision in it construe in favor of survival.

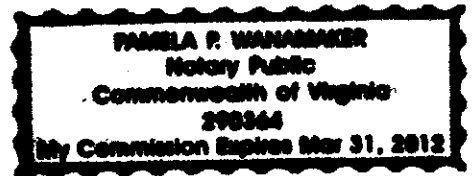
